## Examples of Fishing Related Items Found on Cornish Beaches

Anglers' fishing floats



Anglers' line  
(monofilament or braid)



Angler's line items  
(beads, booms that are threaded onto line)



Anglers' lures



Cable ties (not exclusively fishing related)



Crab pots



Bait box



Conveyer belts parts used on the larger fishing vessels



Fish Boxes



Fishermen's gloves



Fishermen's glove packets (Showa)



Fishermen's kisses. These are offcuts left after repairing nets



Fishing industry longline fishing line (sometimes with hooks)



Fishing industry 'long line' hooks with foam strip. Usually just the foam strip is found



Fishing industry longline fishing rope with and without floats (sometimes used with crab & lobster pots)



Fishing industry netting floats



Hand lines. Commonly used for crabbing or trailing behind a boat.



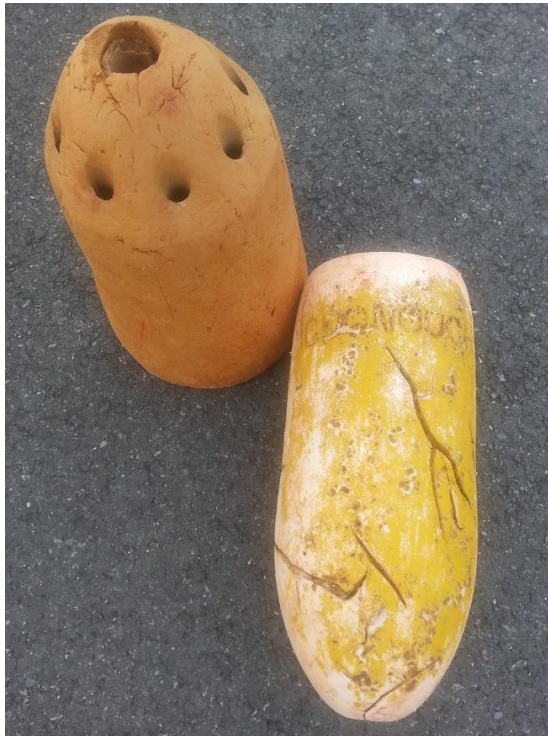
Glow sticks used by anglers and fishing industry
